Dear Members of the Public Utilities Commission:

This letter will serve as the first quarterly report pursuant to the order of the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) issued July 30, 2012 relative to Host Community Premium Surcharge (HCPS) fees to be assessed by the Guam Solid Waste Authority (GSWA). GSWA began assessing the fees on October 1, 2012. This report will cover the period from October 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012. The following table outlines the HCPS fees charged and actually collected during the quarter ended December 31, 2012:

GSWA billed \$77,726.39 in HCPS fees during the quarter ending December 31, 2012. However, under Guam Law, customers of GSWA are allowed sixty days to pay their solid waste bill. As a result, most of the fee billed in the quarter ending December 31, 2012 will not be collected until the next reporting period. Based on actual payments received during the quarter ending December 31, 2012, there is \$15,720.03 in cash available from HCPS fees on December 31, 2012. The balance is a receivable, most of which should be collected during the next reporting period.

We are in the process of establishing the bank account envisioned by your order dated July 30, 2012, into which HCPS fees will be deposited pending their transfer to the Department of Administration. However, we are ready to transfer the cash on hand on December 31, 2012 to the Department of Administration immediately. By copy of this letter to the
