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### **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS For Consulting Services (Relative to the Port Authority of Guam) RFP No. 003-FY18**

The Guam Public Utilities Commission wishes to receive proposals for the performance of consulting services relative to the Commission's regulatory oversight supervision of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port, the Port Authority of Guam ["PAG"]. PAG is responsible for providing for the needs of ocean commerce, shipping, recreational and commercial boating, and navigation of the territory of Guam. By virtue of 12 Guam Code Annotated Sec. 10104(j), the Guam Public Utilities Commission exercises regulatory oversight supervision of PAG and is responsible for establishing and modifying all rates, dockage, rentals, tolls, pilotage, wharfage and charges for the use and occupation of the public facilities or appliances of the Port, and for services rendered by the Port and to provide for the collection thereof.

The Commission seeks a consultant to assist and advise it with regard to all aspects of its regulatory duties.

Offerors are required to have background and knowledge regarding the operation and finances of commercial ports. The selected offeror will analyze applications for rate adjustments, economic and financial data of the PAG, loan documentation and bond issues, and other matters relating to the operation and finances of the PAG. The offeror is required to have accounting skills and familiarity with the rate setting process for public utilities.

The RFP will be issued on Tuesday May 1, 2018. All interested persons or firms are requested to obtain copies of RFP No. 003-FY18 at the Guam Public Utilities Commission, Suite 207, GCIC Building, 414 W. RFP copies may be picked up Monday through Friday, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., with the exception of official Government holidays.

A non-refundable fee of \$25.00 is required.

Potential offerors may submit written questions on or before Thursday June 7, 2018. Responses to the written questions will be made on or before Thursday June 14, 2018. Submission of proposals will be due by 5:00 p.m. (Guam local time) on or before Tuesday July 10, 2018. Please make reference to RFP No. 003-FY18 on all submissions. Proposals must be received by Guam Public Utilities Commission on or before the due date to be considered for evaluation.
