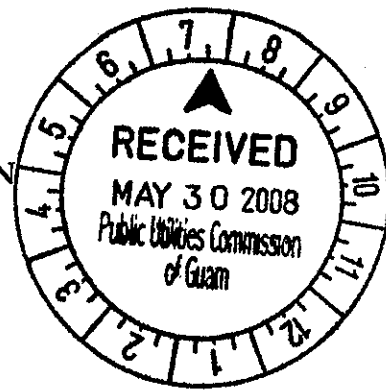



ORDER


In furtherance of section five of the Guam Public Utilities Commission's August 13, 2007 *Order Approving Interconnection Agreement* herein, its administrative law judge [ALJ] has conducted proceedings to examine whether IT&E Overseas Inc. [ITE] should be required to reimburse the parties in Docket 05-11 [GTA and Pacific Data Systems] for a portion of the regulatory expenses, which they incurred in negotiating interconnection prices, which ITE elected to adopt in this docket. These proceedings are summarized in ALJ's March 27, 2008 report. After careful review of ALJ's report, the record of the subject proceeding, for good cause shown and on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried by the undersigned commissioners, the Guam Public Utilities Commission **HEREBY ORDERS THAT:**

1. IT&E Overseas, Inc. shall promptly remit to PUC the sum of \$23,287.00, which sum shall be disbursed by PUC in equal portions to GTA and Pacific Data Systems in partial reimbursement for the regulatory expenses, which they incurred in negotiating interconnection prices, which ITE elected to adopt in its interconnection agreement with GTA.
2. PUC reserves the right and authority under 12 GCA § 12104[c][7] to reallocate and apportion in such manner as it may determine, a fair share of these and other regulatory expenses to any other telecommunications company, which seeks interconnection with GTA and elects to adopt the pricing, terms or conditions which have been crafted in this proceeding.


