DECISION AND ORDER

On January 28, 1998, Guam International Country Club [GICC] filed an application with the Commission for authority to establish or expand, the following discount green fee programs ["programs"] for Guam residents, effective April 1, 1998:

- a. A \$5.00 twilight rate discount from established green fee rates for 18 hole play for Guam residents, but not in addition to Guam senior and junior discounts, on non-holiday weekdays for non-reservation play commencing between 2:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- b. A senior discount from established green rates of \$5.00 for 18 hole play and \$2.00 for 9 hole play on non-holiday weekday afternoons [after 11:00 a.m. during April -September and after 11:30 a.m. during October - March] for Guam residents of the age of 55 or older.
- c. The extension of Guam junior resident discounted play access to include all non-holiday weekday afternoons [as defined in paragraph (b) above].

At a duly noticed public hearing convened at 6:00 p.m., February 26, 1998, at Room 202, GCIC Building, Agana, the Commission received a stipulation [copy enclosed] by which GICC and Georgetown Consulting Group endorsed Commission approval of the GICC application. Mr. Ted Abella, during the public comment segment of the hearing, registered concern about the fairness of the senior discount start times.

At a duly noticed special meeting held at 6:00 p.m. on February 27, 1998, the Commission met to consider the stipulation and public comment. After such examination and review, in the exercise of its judgment and for good cause shown, and on motion duly made, seconded and carried, the Commission **ORDERS THAT:**


1. The stipulation between the parties herein dated February 25, 1998 and the programs proposed therein are approved; provided, however, that:

a. GICC shall implement and provide reasonable public notice of the programs on or before April 1, 1998; and


b. Consistent with the mandate of 12 GCA §12004 and §12015, prior Commission approval shall be required for the abatement or amendment of any such program.

2. GICC shall pay for the Commission's expenses, including without limitation, consulting and counsel fees and the expenses of conducting and transcribing the hearing proceedings regarding this regulatory matter.




