Subject: RE: Cancellation of PUC Meeting for August 27, 2020

Dear Commissioners:

Based upon the Governor's return of the island to PCOR1, the Chairman thought it appropriate to cancel the PUC Meeting for August 27, 2020.

Also, we had previously scheduled public hearings for August 20 and 25th in GPA Docket 20-10, Creation of a Condominium Rate Schedule "D". However, the Mayor Offices of Dededo and Asan do not want us to hold public hearings in their village facilities because of the return to PCOR1. Therefore,

the public hearings will have to be rescheduled at a future time.

There is one matter which was scheduled to be heard this month, GPA Docket 20-18, Petition for One Month Extension for RFO6 for Baseload Generating Plants, which has urgency for immediate action. I previously sent you the ALJ Report and Proposed Order in the matter.

The RFO No. 6 Contract with Mobil will terminate at the end of this month. GPA has requested a one month extension. Unless action is taken, the contract will lapse.

GPA would be left without a Fuel Supplier for one month.

There is a procedure the PUC has used in the past on many occasions to deal with this type of situation. 12 GCA §12105(b) authorizes the Commission to act through one Commissioner in certain instances. The PUC Administrative Resolution, dated April 11, 2002, authorizes the Chairman to act on behalf of the Commission when action cannot await the next meeting. When this procedure is used, the Chairman's action is subject to ratification by the entire Commission at the next month's meeting.

I suggest that the Chairman sign the proposed Order in GPA Docket 20-18, subject to Commission ratification at the next meeting. I would appreciate it if you each could let me know if you concur with this procedure. Thank you.
