Surcharges

On behalf of the Guam Public Utilities Commission, it is my pleasure to submit a Summary FY2017 Report of the Guam Public Utilities Commission [PUC] detailing the receipts, collections and amounts of the Enhanced 911 Emergency System Surcharges. This Report was prepared by the PUC Commission Staff.

The attached Report indicates that Net Revenues of \$2,331,538.03 were collected by Guam Telecom Companies from the E911 Surcharge in FY 2017.

Under Public Law 28-44, PUC was previously required by Section 3 thereof to submit an annual Report to I Maga lahen Guåhan, the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan, and the Public Auditor of Guam, concerning receipts and collections of Enhanced 911 Emergency System Surcharges.

However, the PUC has determined that this prior reporting obligation of the PUC concerning the E911 Surcharge was deleted by I Liheslaturan Guihan in Public Law 32-096. The PUC Reporting requirement previously contained in Section 3 of Public Law 25-55, as amended by Public Law 28-44, was not contained in the amendment of Section 3 by Public Law 32-096.

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The Compiler of Laws subsequently codified previous laws dealing with the E911 Surcharge in 12 GCA Chapter 12, Article 3. There is no requirement in 12 GCA Sec. 12303, Collection of "911 Surcharge," or other codified provision, that PUC submit an annual report on E911.

Therefore, this will be the final report submitted by PUC concerning the E911 Surcharge.
