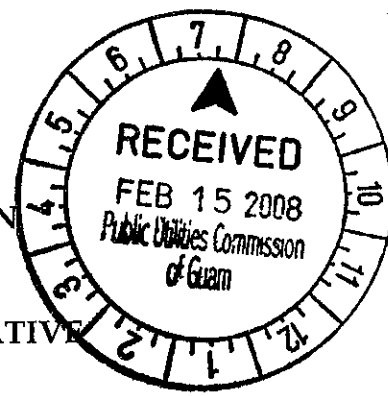



ORDER

The Guam Public Utilities Commission [PUC], having reviewed the February 8, 2008 report of its administrative law judge [ALJ] regarding the need to amend the contract review protocol by which PUC regulates the procurements of Guam Power Authority [GPA] under 12 GCA § 12004 and for good cause shown, on motion duly made, seconded and carried by the affirmative vote of the undersigned commissioners hereby **ORDERS THAT:**

1. The subject of appropriate amendments to GPA's contract review protocol, in form established by PUC's May 26, 2007 shall be prepared by ALJ for PUC consideration during the May 2008 regulatory session.
2. ALJ is authorized and directed to seek an advisory opinion from the Public Auditor regarding the legal exposure to which GPA's certifying officer would be exposed by authorizing the expenditure of public funds for a contract, which requires but has not received PUC approval.
3. A copy of this Order shall be delivered to GPA and to the Consolidated Commission on Utilities. Special attention should be given to the concerns raised in Mr. Blair's December 16, 1998 regarding a utility's violation of the contract protocol and to the ALJ report, which recounts PUC's serious concern over GPA's persistent violation of the protocol.




