**PUBLIC NOTICE OF JOINT APPLICATION OF TELEGUAM HOLDINGS
LLC AND GTA TELECOM LLC FOR EXPEDITED PUC APPROVAL OF THE
ASSIGNMENT AND TRANSFER OF THE CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY
AND ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER CERTIFICATE FROM
GTA TELECOM LLC TO TELEGUAM HOLDINGS LLC**

On December 19, 2011, Teleguam Holdings LLC and GTA Telecom LLC filed a Joint Application for expedited PUC approval of the assignment and transfer of the Certificate of Authority and Eligible Telecommunications Carrier Certificate from GTA Telecom LLC to Teleguam Holdings LLC.

Pursuant to 12 GCA §12103 (c) and(g), a telecommunications company may not sell, assign, or transfer a certificate of authority without the prior approval of the PUC and upon certain determinations by the Commission as required by statute.

Notice of this Joint Application is hereby given to the public pursuant to 12 GCA §12103 (c). Interested persons may file comments for the record regarding the Joint Application. Comments, which must be received by the PUC on or before February 6, 2012, should be mailed, delivered, or e-mailed to:

The Joint Application may be reviewed at the PUC Office or at the PUC website at www.guampuc.com.

The PUC will conduct a public hearing, commencing at 6:00 p.m. on February 9, 2012, in Suite 202 GCIC Building, 414 W. Soledad Ave., Hagatna, to receive public comment and testimony from interested parties on the above referenced Joint Application. The PUC must decide whether the proposed sale or transfer satisfies the requirements for granting a certificate of authority: (1) whether the applicant possesses sufficient technical, financial, and managerial resources and abilities to provide the telecommunications services in Guam for which it seeks a certificate of authority; and (2) whether the granting of a certificate of authority to the applicant would not be contrary to the public interest.
