This matter comes before the Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") of the Guam Public Utilities Commission ("GPUC") on the 3rd day of February, 2012, for scheduling of further proceedings regarding the Petition of the Bureau of Information Technology ("BIT") against GTA TeleGuam Holdings LLC ("GTA"). GTA, BIT, and Pacific Data Systems Inc. ("PDS") appeared through both counsel and their authorized representatives.

Having heard the positions of the parties relative to scheduling of further proceedings in this matter, the ALJ establishes the following schedule:

- 1. Requests for production of documents may be submitted by any party to the other parties commencing on February 7, 2012;
- 2. Parties shall respond to any request for production served upon them on or before February 21, 2012;
- 3. On or before February 27, 2012, the parties will submit a stipulation as to persons to be deposed, and the scheduling of such depositions;
- 4. If any party seeks to depose any individual not listed on the Stipulation, a request for such deposition must be submitted to the ALJ, and prior permission obtained, before such deposition is taken;
- 5. Depositions shall be completed by the close of business on March 16, 2012;
- 6. Parties shall file lists of witnesses to be called, and exhibits to be introduced, with the Commission on or before March 21, 2012. Documents previously filed shall be deemed to be part of the record herein and need not be refilled or reintroduced;

- 7. The evidentiary hearing in this matter will be conducted on March 28, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. at the PUC Office;
- 8. The parties have stipulated on the record that they agree to extend the 180 day period for resolution of complaints under 12 GCA §12107, until April 16, 2012.
