**PUBLIC NOTICE OF JOINT APPLICATION OF TELEGUAM HOLDINGS
LLC AND GTA TELECOM LLC FOR PUC APPROVAL OF THE TRANSFER
OF CONTROL OF TELEGUAM HOLDINGS LLC AND GTA TELECOM LLC
TO AP TELEGUAM HOLDINGS LLC**

On November 19, 2010, Teleguam Holdings LLC and GTA Telecom LLC filed a Joint Application for Approval by the PUC of transfer of ownership and control of Teleguam Holdings LLC and GTA Telecom LLC to AP Teleguam Holdings, LLC. If the sale is approved, a group referred to as the “AP Funds” will purchase all of the ownership interest of the current owners, Shamrock Capital Advisors, in Teleguam Holdings LLC.

When there is a substantial change of ownership, or a change in control, of a company holding a Certificate of Authority to provide telecommunications services in Guam, such change of ownership or transfer of control must be approved by the PUC before it is effective. 12 GCA §§12103(c) and (g).

The PUC Administrative Law Judge has ordered that notice of this Joint Application be given to the public, that the public have an opportunity to comment, and that a public hearing be scheduled before the PUC at which time the public and interested parties will have an opportunity to comment and/or testify.

Interested persons may file comments for the record regarding the Joint Application. Comments, which must be received by the PUC on or before January 24, 2011, should be mailed, delivered, or e-mailed to:

The Joint Application and other relevant materials in this Docket may be reviewed at the PUC Office or at the PUC website at www.guampuc.com.

The PUC will conduct a public hearing, commencing at 6:00 p.m. on January 27, 2011 in Suite 202 GCIC Building, 414 W. Soledad Ave., Hagatna , to receive public comment and testimony on the above referenced Joint Application. The PUC must decide whether the proposed sale or transfer satisfies the requirements for granting a certificate of authority: (1) whether the applicant possesses sufficient technical, financial, and managerial resources and abilities to provide the telecommunications services in Guam for which it seeks a certificate of authority; and (2) whether the granting of a certificate of authority to the applicant would not be contrary to the public interest.
