**SCHEDULING ORDER**

This matter came before the Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) of the Guam Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) on Wednesday, February 10, 2010 for a Scheduling Conference. Representatives of GTA TeleGuam LLC (“GTA”) and Guam Power Authority (“GPA”) were present along with their counsel. Representatives from IT&E and Docomo were also present.

After hearing discussions of counsel, the ALJ issued the following schedule:

1. On March 10, 2010, GTA shall submit a brief in support of its Formal Complaint filed on October 30, 2009 or, in the alternative, GTA and GPA may submit a proposed Stipulation.
2. In the event that GTA submits a brief on March 10, 2010, then GPA and any telecommunications company claiming an interest in this matter may submit a response thereto on April 1, 2010. In the event that GTA and GPA submit a Stipulation on March 10, 2010, then any telecommunications company claiming an interest in this matter may likewise submit a response on April 1, 2010.
3. GTA may submit a response on April 8, 2010, to any filings on April 1, 2010.

4. Once the filings referred to herein are received the ALJ shall determine whether it is necessary to schedule another status conference or take other action such as converting this into a rate proceeding.
