STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES
REGARDING APPORTIONMENT
OF ADMINISTRATIVE
ASSESSMENTS

This Stipulation is made this 11th day of January, 2018, by and between TeleGuam Holdings, LLC (“GTA”), Pacific Data Systems, Inc. (“PDS”), Docomo Pacific, Inc. (“DPAC”), PTI Pacifica, Inc. (“IT&E”), and Choice Phone, LLC (“iConnect”). GTA, PDS, DPAC, IT&E and iConnect may be referred to collectively as the “Parties.”

WHEREAS, the Guam Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) oversees power, water, telecommunications, waste and other utilities within Guam; and

WHEREAS, the PUC receives no funding from the Guam Legislature other than the assessments it is permitted by Guam law to collect from the utilities under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, assessments against telecom companies to cover administrative and operational expenses (“Administrative Assessments”) are governed by the PUC’s Rules Governing Regulatory Fees for Telecommunications Companies dated July 27, 2005 (the “Rules”);

WHEREAS, the Rules provide that costs of PUC regulatory activities, which are of material interest to some or all of the carriers, are to be allocated proportionally among all carriers with a material interest in the proceeding based on an interested carrier’s percentage of the gross revenues of all interested carriers; and

WHEREAS, the PUC has thereby collected Administrative Assessments only from telecom companies that utilize the PUC’s regulatory services; and

WHEREAS, some telecom companies in Guam have historically had little or no material interest in cases or issues before the PUC and have not been subjected to Administrative Assessments by the PUC; and

WHEREAS, because the PUC is statutorily mandated to oversee all telecom companies providing services within Guam, regardless of whether a telecom company actually comes before the PUC, and because the PUC conducts regulatory actions such as E911 surcharge oversight and Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) certifications, that are of material interest to most, if not all, telecom companies, it is fair that all telecom companies share in the administrative costs necessary to keep the PUC in operation.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, terms and conditions set forth herein, the Parties agree as follows:

1. A portion of the Administrative Assessments, which are necessary for the day-to-day operations of the PUC, shall be paid by the Local Exchange Carriers and Commercial Mobile Radio Services providers as Baseline Annual Assessments as follows:

2. Any remaining Administrative Assessments shall be apportioned among the Parties in percentages determined by each company's PUC docket activity in the prior year.
3. Assessment of costs for specific regulatory activities between any of the Parties ("Regulatory Assessments") before the PUC, such as disputes, shall be assessed against those Parties as ordered by the PUC.
4. The Parties hereby respectfully request the PUC to amend the Rules accordingly.
