PUBLIC NOTICE

On April 4, 2016, TELEGUAM HOLDINGS LLC [GTA] filed Tariff Transmittal No. 25 with the Guam Public Utilities Commission [PUC] under the Guam Telecommunications Act of 2004 and the PUC Rules for Practice and Procedure. GTA seeks PUC approval of an increase in GTA's Residence Monthly Local Exchange Access Line Rate from \$14.00 to \$16.00.

GTA's Residence Monthly Local Exchange Access Line Rate is the charge that Residential customers pay for basic land line service.

Tariff Transmittal No. 25 would amend Section 111(A) of GTA's General Exchange Tariff No. 1. GTA's Transmittal states that an increase in the Residence Monthly Local Exchange Access Line Rate is required by recent Orders of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). If GTA does not raise the Residence Monthly Local Exchange Access Line Rate, the FCC will likely reduce the amount of Universal Support Funds that GTA receives from the Federal Government for Interstate Common Line Support.

GTA utilizes USF to make needed improvements to its telecommunications network infrastructure on Guam.

PUC will examine the tariff pursuant to 12 GCA §12206[e] and determine, after an opportunity for hearing, whether the Tariff should be approved, rejected, or approved with conditions, or make any other appropriate Order. The PUC welcomes public comments regarding what action is should take on Tariff Transmittal No. 25.

GTA's Residence Monthly Local Exchange Access Line Rate Tariff is available for public inspection at PUC's office at Suite 207 GCIC Building, Hagatna, on PUC's website at [www.guampuc.com](http://www.guampuc.com), and on GTA's website. Public Comments regarding the tariff should be filed with PUC on or before April 18, 2016. A Public Hearing will be conducted on this tariff on April 19, 2016, at Suite 202 GCIC Building, Hagatna, at 6:00 p.m., at which time members of the public or interested parties will be provided with an opportunity to comment on the Tariff.
