<b>Formal Complaint of Teleguam Holdings, LLC, Regarding PDS Informal Complaint of June 22, 2015 Disputing UNE Loop Invoices</b>	)	<b>PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER</b>

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This matter comes before the Guam Public Utilities Commission [“PUC”] upon the Formal Complaint of Teleguam Holdings, LLC, filed September 18, 2015. The Parties convened at the PUC Office for a prehearing conference, pursuant to Rule 25 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice, on November 25, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. GTA was represented by its Counsel Serge Quenga and its Executive Vice President Dan Tydingco. PDS was represented by its Counsel Bill Mann and its President John Day. The Administrative Law Judge, having conducted the hearing and having heard the representations of the Parties, and good cause appearing, hereby holds as follows:

1. The Parties have resolved issues concerning payments relating to the Hagatna wire center; however, there is no agreement as payment concerning loops outside of Hagatna.
2. The setting of a Hearing in this matter is necessary as the Parties have indicated that there is no possibility of settling the outstanding issues at the present time.
3. The Hearing in this matter shall be held on Tuesday, December 22, 9:00 a.m., at the PUC Office, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor GCIC Building in Hagatna, Guam (this hearing date was subsequently stipulated to by the Parties on November 23, 2015). The hearing will be completed on that date.
4. By close of business on December 17, 2015, the parties will file with the PUC, and serve upon the other party herein, a List of Witnesses and copies of the Exhibits which they intend to introduce at the hearing. If possible, the Parties shall stipulate to the admissibility of Exhibits. All filings of the Parties to date herein shall be deemed to be a part of the Record.
