This matter comes before the Guam Public Utilities Commission (the "PUC") pursuant to a Petition filed by the Jose G. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port, Port Authority of Guam ("PAG") on June 19, 2012, whereby PAG requests review and approval of the Agreement for the Sales Agreement, and the Interim Maintenance Agreement, related to the Port of Los Angeles cranes.

The instant matter was scheduled to be heard in the July 30, 2012 PUC meeting. However, Slater Nakamura, consultants for the PUC (hereinafter referred to as the "Consultants"), have requested that this matter be continued until the next PUC meeting. The request for continuance is based on the Consultants' aim in fully investigating options that may be more cost effective for PAG.

The Consultants project that a draft report will be completed by August 9, 2012. The Consultants propose that PAG be afforded the opportunity to review the draft report and submit any comments by August 16, 2012. The ALJ finds this request reasonable and, accordingly, continues the matter until the next PUC meeting, which shall afford PAG the opportunity to respond to any report and recommendation filed by the Consultants.
