PACIFIC DATA SYSTEM INC.'S
PETITION FOR ARBRITRATION OF
INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This matter comes before the Guam Public Utilities Commission [“PUC”] pursuant to the April 22, 2014 Petition for Compulsory Arbitration of the PDS-GTA Interconnection Agreement. At the preliminary scheduling hearing on May 2, 2014 at 9:00 a.m., Pacific Data Systems Inc. [PDS] appeared through its President John Day; Teleguam Holdings LLC [GTA] was represented by its counsel Serge Quenga, and its Vice President Daniel Tydingco and Lucia Perez, Managing Director, Legal, Regulatory, Security & External Affairs. After discussion between Administrative Law Judge and the parties, the following scheduling in this matter was agreed to:

1. There shall be a sixty day time frame for the arbitration of issues related to the Interconnection Agreement between PDS and GTA.
2. No later than May 23, 2014, the parties will submit to each other a redline version of the initial changes that each party requests to the present Interconnection Agreement. The parties shall address all of the issues set forth in Exhibit "B" to the PDS Petition [Status of ICA Negotiations]. Each party shall send its requested changes to the Administrative Law Judge.
3. On May 30, 2014, at 1:30 p.m., PDS and GTA, through its relevant officers, shall meet and negotiate concerning the changes to the Interconnection Agreement proposed by each party. The parties shall continue meeting as necessary to negotiate the applicable issues.
4. On June 6, 2014, at 9:00 a.m., at the PUC Office, a status conference shall be held with the parties and the Administrative Law Judge. At that time, such additional schedules as required to complete the negotiation of issues, and to schedule arbitration proceedings, if necessary, shall be established.
5. The parties are instructed to comply with their duties and obligations pursuant to this Order and to undertake good faith negotiations.
