PDS DOCKET 14-01 "TRUE-UP" ORDER

This is matter comes before the Administrative Law Judge ["ALJ"] upon the Order of the Guam Public Utilities Commission ["PUC"] dated April 13, 2017. Therein, the Commission ordered that there be a "True-Up" accounting concerning the 12 "permanent" UNE rates for loops approved, and those loop rates which PDS had paid during the "True-Up" period.

The ALJ, having considered the representations of the Parties, and good cause appearing, hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

- The True-Up calculations and spreadsheets provided by GTA to PDS and the Commission on June 12, 2017, are agreed to by PDS and adopted by the Commission.
- 2. In accordance with said True-Up calculations and spreadsheets, GTA owes a refund of \$165,449.16 to PDS, and a credit of \$15,163.06.
- 3. By agreement of the Parties, GTA will pay the refund amount due to PDS on or before June 23, 2017. GTA will also provide the agreed credit to PDS.
