COMES NOW, the GUAM POWER AUTHORITY (GPA), by and through its counsel of record, D. GRAHAM BOTHA, ESQ., and hereby files GPA's Petition for the Public Utilities Commission of Guam to review and approve GPA's request for approval of the contract with TEMES, Inc. for the Yigo CT Repairs, as follows:

BACKGROUND

The Guam Power Authority contracted with TEMES, Inc. for PMC services for Yigo CT. The Yigo Combustion Turbine (CT) tripped on May 14, 2021 due to high vibration, and a borescope inspection revealed broken turbine blades near the turbine frame. TEMES, the PMC contractor for the Yigo CT has recommended the replacement of the engine at a cost not to exceed \$3.5 million. GPA has identified 2014 bond funds, and is requesting to reallocate these bond funds for the Yigo CT repair. The CCU in Resolution 2021-15 has approved GPA's request to contract for the generator repairs for Yigo CT through the PMC, TEMES, Inc., in the amount of \$3,500,000 using re-allocated 2014 bond funds.

DISCUSSION

GPA hereby petitions the PUC, pursuant to the Contract Review Protocol for the Guam Power Authority, approved by the PUC, to review and approve the contract with TEMES, Inc.

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for generator repairs for Yigo CT. In support of this Petition, GPA hereby provides the PUC with Consolidated Commission on Utilities (CCU) Resolution No. 2021-15, which authorizes the General Manager to proceed with the contract with the PMC, subject to PUC approval. Said resolution and its exhibits are attached herein as Exhibit A, and incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth.

CONCLUSION

The PUC should approve GPA's request to proceed with the contract with TEMES, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$3,500,000 for the generator repairs of Yigo CT. The Yigo CT unit is essential to the island wide power system, and the contract is reasonable, prudent, and necessary.

AUTHORIZING MANAGEMENT OF THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE REPAIRS REQUIRED TO PLACE YIGO COMBUSTION TURBINE POWER PLANT IN SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Yigo Combustion Turbine (CT) power plant has been in operation for approximately 25 years and is used to support peak loads and base load unit outages as well to respond to the intermittency of solar generation; and

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2021 the unit tripped due to high vibration; and a boroscope inspection revealed broken turbine blades near the turbine mid frame; and

WHEREAS, TEMES, the Performance Management Contractor (PMC) for the CT has recommended the replacement of the engine at a cost not to exceed \$3.5 million; and

WHEREAS, the loss of Yigo CT further reduces GPA's capacity by up to 20 MW; and

WHEREAS, GPA and the PMC intend to maximize the downtime of the unit to complete necessary repairs and return the unit as soon as possible to support the IWPS; and

WHEREAS, GPA has identified 2014 bond funds and is also requesting to reallocate these bond funds for the repair of the Yigo CT as shown on Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, approval is requested to allow the General Manager to petition the PUC to approve the implementation and completion of repairs needed for the Yigo CT, including the reallocation of 2014 bond funds not to exceed \$3.5 million for this project.
