COMES NOW, the GUAM POWER AUTHORITY (GPA), by and through its counsel of record, D. GRAHAM BOTHA, ESQ., and hereby files GPA's Petition for the Public Utilities Commission of Guam to review and approve GPA's request to approve the contract extension for Professional Printing, Mailing, Processing and Other Services with Graphic Center, Inc., as follows:

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Guam Power Authority on April 6, 2016 entered into a five-year contract, including base year and options to provide Professional Printing, Mailing, Processing and Other Services with Graphic Center, Inc. GPA put out a new IFB for services in December 2020, but the sole bidder did not meet the bid requirements, so GPA was forced to rebid. While the 5-year contract was below the \$1.5M PUC threshold, the month to month bid extension, until a new bid is awarded will exceed \$1.5M. The CCU in Resolution 2021-10 has approved GPA's request to approve the contract extension for Professional Printing, Mailing, Processing and Other Services with Graphic Center, Inc., subject to PUC approval.

#### **DISCUSSION**

GPA hereby petitions the PUC, pursuant to the Contract Review Protocol for the Guam Power Authority, approved by the PUC, to review and approve the contract extension for Professional Printing, Mailing, Processing and Other Services with Graphic Center, Inc. at an additional cost of \$300,000 for eight months. In support of this Petition, GPA hereby provides the PUC with Consolidated Commission on Utilities (CCU) Resolution No. 2021-10, which authorizes the General Manager to petition the PUC for approval of the Contract extension for Professional Printing, Mailing, Processing and Other Services with Graphic Center, Inc., subject to PUC review and approval. Said resolution and its exhibits are attached herein as Exhibit A, and incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth.

#### **CONCLUSION**

The PUC should approve GPA's request to approve the Contract extension for Professional Printing, Mailing, Processing and Other Services with Graphic Center, Inc. The printing services are necessary for GPA monthly billings, and is reasonable, prudent, and necessary.
