COMES NOW, the GUAM POWER AUTHORITY (GPA), by and through its counsel of record, D. GRAHAM BOTHA, ESQ., and hereby files GPA's Petition for the Public Utilities Commission of Guam to review and approve the Contract with Tristar Terminals Guam, Inc. for the lease extension for Tank 1906 and 1907 for diesel fuel, as follows:

BACKGROUND

The Guam Power Authority has a contract with Tristar Terminals Inc. for the lease of diesel fuel tanks 1906 and 1907. The ULSD Storage agreement for Tank 1906 will expire on December 31, 2022 and the Tank 1907 lease will expire on June 30, 2023. GPA has negotiated an extension for both Tank 1906 and 1907 through June 30, 2024. The CCU in Resolution FY2023-04 has approved the request for the lease extension for Tank 1906 at approximately \$1,666,000 and for Tank 1907 at \$1,176,000 for a total cost for both tanks of approximately \$2,842,000.

DISCUSSION

GPA hereby petitions the PUC, pursuant to the Contract Review Protocol for the Guam Power Authority, approved by the PUC, to review and approve the Contract with Tristar Terminals Guam, Inc. for the lease extension of Tank 1906 and Tank 1907 through June 30,

2024. In support of this Petition, GPA hereby provides the PUC with Consolidated Commission on Utilities (CCU) Resolution No. FY2023-04, which authorizes the General Manager to enter into a contract with Tristar Terminal Guam, Inc. for an extension of the Tank 1906 lease from January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 and the Tank 1907 lease from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. Said resolution and its exhibits are attached herein as Exhibit A, and incorporated by reference herein as if fully set forth.

CONCLUSION

The PUC should approve GPA's request to proceed with the Contract with Tristar Terminals Guam, Inc. for the extension of the Tank 1906 lease from January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 and the Tank 1907 lease from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. The contract extension with Tristar Terminal Guam, Inc. is reasonable, prudent, and necessary.

AUTHORIZING THE MANAGEMENT OF THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY TO EXTEND THE ULSD STORAGE LEASE AGREEMENT WITH TRISTAR TERMINALS GUAM, INC.

WHEREAS, GPA currently lease tanks for Ultra-Low Sulfur Diesel Fuel (hereinafter referred to as "ULSD") storage from Tristar Terminals Guam, Inc (hereinafter referred to as "TTGI") under reference agreement TTGI-SA-2018-01; and

WHEREAS, the ULSD Storage Agreement for the lease of Tank 1906 will expire in December 31, 2022 and the lease of Tank 1907 will expire in June 30, 2023, respectively; and

WHEREAS, GPA and TTGI has negotiated for the extension of the lease of Tank 1906 and Tank 1907 to expire at the same time in June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the lease fee for each tank is approximately \$98,000.00 per month (excluding handling and throughput fees). Tank 1906 lease cost for the extension period from

January 1, 2023 thru June 30, 2024 is approximately \$1,666,000.00. Tank 1907 lease cost for the extension period from July 1, 2023 thru June 30, 2024 is approximately \$1,176,000.00. The aggregate total lease cost for both tanks is approximately \$2,842,000.00 (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, GPA is seeking the approval of the CCU for the extension of the lease of the ULSD storage tanks to expire in June 30, 2024.

NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Consolidated Commission on Utilities, subject to the review and approval of the Guam Public Utilities Commission, as follows:

- GPA's request to extend the lease of the ULSD storage tanks to ensure adequacy
 of supply to the power plants is reasonable and prudent.
- GPA is authorized to enter into an agreement with Tristar Terminals Guam, Inc.
 for the extension of the lease of the ULSD storage tanks thru June 30, 2024.
- 3. The General Manager of the Guam Power Authority is hereby authorized an increase in obligating authority to the annual value of the contract and execute such agreements and documents necessary for a contract with TRISTAR TERMINALS GUAM, INC.
