AUTHORIZING THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY (GPA) TO PETITION THE PUC FOR APPROVAL TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR THE MANAGEMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY'S FUEL BULK STORAGE FACILITY

WHEREAS, GPA's current contract with Isla Petroleum and Energy LLC for the management of the GPA Fuel Bulk Storage Facility under GPA-014-17 is set to expire on September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Authority issued a new Multi-Step Invitation for Re-Bid under IFB GPA-015-22 for the Management, Operation, and Maintenance of the Fuel Bulk Storage Facility on June 2022; and

WHEREAS, IP&E Guam LLC, and Supreme Group Guam LLC submitted bids for GPA's consideration (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, Supreme Group Guam LLC has been determined to be the lowest, most responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for the 3-year base period with Supreme Group Guam LLC is \$2,728,321 for the mandatory services; and

WHEREAS, this contract is for an initial term of 3 years with two optional one-year extensions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Consolidated Commission on Utilities does hereby approve the following:

- The General Manager of GPA is authorized to petition the PUC for approval to enter into a contract with Supreme Group Guam LLC for the Management, Operation, and Maintenance of the Guam Power Authority Fuel Bulk Storage Facility.
- 2. The General Manager of GPA is hereby authorized an increase in obligating authority to \$2,728,321 for the three-year base period of the contract for mandatory services.

 RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Commission certifies and the Secretary of the Commission attests the adoption of this Resolution.
