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18 The GUAM POWER AUTHORITY (GPA), by and through its counsel of record,
19 MARIANNE WOLOSCHUK, hereby files its Petition for the Public Utilities Commission of
20 Guam (PUC) to review and approve GPA's request to purchase certain medium-sized Water
21 System Diesel (WSD) Generators.
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23 **I. BACKGROUND**

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25 The GPA WSD division operates and maintains over two hundred twenty (220) standby
26 generators for the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) water wells, waste water facilities, and
27 water booster pump stations, including the approximately ninety (90) standby generators
28 transferred in 2015 from GWA to GPA. The Consolidated Commission on Utilities (CCU), in
29 Resolution No. FY2024-06, authorized GPA to procure one hundred four (104) generators to
30 provide or replace damaged or down generators at an estimated total cost of \$9.5 million. The

32 procurement was separated by size into three (3) bids to minimize potential protest impacts.

ORIGINAL

1 GPA bid number GPA-048-24 concerns the medium-sized generators and includes forty-
2 nine (49) stationary generator sizes 125 kW (20 each), 175 kW (13 each), and 300 kW (16 each);
3 and 11 portable generators with trailers, consisting of sizes 125kW (3 each), 175 kW (5 each), and
4 300 kW (3 each); for an overall total of sixty (60) generators. This portion of the generator bid
5 does not include installation; rather, this bid will supply the generators and GPA WSD division
6 will install them.
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9 II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

10 The PUC contract review protocol requires PUC authorization for all contracts in excess
11 of \$1.5 million. The final cost of this portion of the procurement of generators accounts for
12 \$3,006,527.48 of the estimated \$9.5 million originally approved for the 104 generators. The bid
13 committee for GPA-048-24 has evaluated the bidders and has recommended that GPA award this
14 procurement to the lowest, most responsive and responsible bidder. In support of this petition,
15 GPA hereby provides the PUC with CCU Resolution No. FY2024-27, which authorizes the
16 General Manager to petition the PUC for its approval to purchase the generators, attached hereto
17 as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
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21 III. CONCLUSION

22 Based on the foregoing, GPA requests that the PUC approve GPA's award of bid
23 GPA-048-24 to the lowest qualified, responsive, and responsible bidder at a cost of \$3,006,527.48.
24 The contract is reasonable, prudent, and necessary.

WHEREAS, GPA bid number GPA-048-24 includes the stationary generator sizes 125 kW (20 ea.), 175 kW (13 ea.), 300 kW (16 ea.) and 11 portable generators, including trailers, consisting of sizes 125 kW (3 ea.), 175 kW (5 ea.) and 300 kW (3ea.); and

WHEREAS, this portion of the generator bid does not include installation. This bid will supply the generators and GPA WSD will install these sizes of generators; and

WHEREAS, the final cost of this portion of generators is \$3,006,527.48 of the estimated \$9.5M originally approved for the 104 generators; and

WHEREAS, the \$3,006,527.48 portion exceeds the GPA General Manager procurement authority; and

WHEREAS, the bid committee for GPA-048-24 has evaluated the bidders and has recommended GPA procurement to award this \$3,006,527.48 amount to the lowest, most responsive and responsible bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Consolidated Commission on Utilities, as follows:


1. The GPA General Manager is authorized to petition the Guam Public Utilities Commission for the approval to award \$3,006,527.48 for bid GPA-048-24 to the lowest qualified, responsive, and responsible bidder.
