GUAM POWER AUTHORITY'S PURCHASE OF WATER SYSTEM DIESEL (WSD) GENERATORS PETITION OF THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF WATER SYSTEM DIESEL (WSD) GENERATORS

The GUAM POWER AUTHORITY (GPA), by and through its counsel of record, MARIANNE WOLOSCHUK, hereby files its Petition for the Public Utilities Commission of Guam (PUC) to review and approve GPA's request to purchase certain medium-sized Water System Diesel (WSD) Generators.

I. BACKGROUND

The GPA WSD division operates and maintains over two hundred twenty (220) standby generators for the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) water wells, waste water facilities, and water booster pump stations, including the approximately ninety (90) standby generators transferred in 2015 from GWA to GPA. The Consolidated Commission on Utilities (CCU), in Resolution No. FY2024-06, authorized GPA to procure one hundred four (104) generators to provide or replace damaged or down generators at an estimated total cost of \$9.5 million. The procurement was separated by size into three (3) bids to minimize potential protest impacts.

Petition of the Guam Power Authority to Approve the Purchase of Water System Diesel (WSD) Generators GPA Docket No. 24-24

GPA bid number GPA-048-24 concerns the medium-sized generators and includes fortynine (49) stationary generator sizes 125 kW (20 each), 175 kW (13 each), and 300 kW (16 each);
and 11 portable generators with trailers, consisting of sizes 125kW (3 each), 175 kW (5 each), and
300 kW (3 each); for an overall total of sixty (60) generators. This portion of the generator bid
does not include installation; rather, this bid will supply the generators and GPA WSD division
will install them.

II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

The PUC contract review protocol requires PUC authorization for all contracts in excess of \$1.5 million. The final cost of this portion of the procurement of generators accounts for \$3,006,527.48 of the estimated \$9.5 million originally approved for the 104 generators. The bid committee for GPA-048-24 has evaluated the bidders and has recommended that GPA award this procurement to the lowest, most responsive and responsible bidder. In support of this petition, GPA hereby provides the PUC with CCU Resolution No. FY2024-27, which authorizes the General Manager to petition the PUC for its approval to purchase the generators, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

III. CONCLUSION

Based on the foregoing, GPA requests that the PUC approve GPA's award of bid GPA-048-24 to the lowest qualified, responsive, and responsible bidder at a cost of \$3,006,527.48. The contract is reasonable, prudent, and necessary.
