COMES NOW, the GUAM WATERWORKS AUTHORITY ("GWA"), by and through its counsel of record, THERESA G. ROJAS, ESQ., and hereby files its Petition seeking the PUC's approval to award an Indefinite Quantity Contract to JMI-Edison for the purchase of Submersible Pumps and Motors and Cables and Splicing Gels for GWA's Deep Wells, Island Wide.

I. BACKGROUND

On August 15, 2024, GWA issued an Invitation to Bid ("IFB") 2024-19 for the procurement of Submersible Pumps and Motors, as well as for Cables and Splicing Gels for GWA's Deep Wells. The procurement was issued as an Indefinite Quantity Award requiring an awarded bidder to maintain sufficient stock and ensure timely replenishment of submersible pumps, motors, cables, and splicing gels as needed. GWA regularly purchases these essential items and maintains a minimum critical inventory level to ensure the reliable production of water island wide.

In response to IFB 2024-19, two interested vendors submitted bids but only JMI-Edison was found responsive and responsible for most of the supplies procured. GWA's review committee evaluated the bid offers, and a copy of the evaluation committee's review is at **Exhibit A.** Tables at **Exhibit A-007-009** also provide a summary of the estimated quantities that GWA is likely to purchase and the unit costs per year for a three-year base term, option years, and total contract costs for the supplies listed below:

- (a) Low Temperature Franklin Electric Submersible Motors
- (b) High Temperature Franklin Electric Submersible Motors
- (c) Franklin Electric and Grundfos Pumps
- (d) 3m Splicing Gels; and
- (e) Paige Electric Submersible Cables

CCU Resolution 11-FY2025 approved the award of a contract to JMI-Edison for Two Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Four Cents (\$2,965,892.04) for the purchase of the aforementioned items for an initial three-year contract term. Additionally, approval was granted for GWA to exercise two possible one-year options for an additional amount of One Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Thirty-Six Cents (\$1,977,261.36). The combined amounts bring the total contract value to Four Million Nine Hundred Forty-Three Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars and Forty Cents (\$4,943,153.40). In addition, the CCU further approved a ten percent (10%) contingency for the potential overall life of the contract (five-year term), totaling Four Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Thirty-Four Cents (\$494,315.34). This contingency brings the total authorized funding to Five Million Four Hundred

Thirty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$5,437,468.74).

II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

Pursuant to its Contract Review Protocol, GWA hereby seeks the PUC's approval to contract with JMI-Edison, to purchase Deep Well Submersible Pumps and Motors and Cables and Splicing Gels for a not to exceed amount of Five Million Four Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$5,437,468.74). This amount covers a needed multi-contract period of up to five (5) years with an initial contract term for three years and two (2) one-year options to renew. GWA requests approval for the full five-year term due to the limited market for these supplies and the critical necessity for GWA to maintain an adequate stock of these items to prevent any interruptions in the water supply.

In support of this Petition, the CCU approved GWA Resolution 11-FY2025. GWA Resolution 11-FY2025. This Resolution is attached with its supporting documents and is attached as **Exhibit A** and is incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

III. CONCLUSION

Based on the foregoing, GWA requests the PUC's approval for the award of an Indefinite Quantity contract with JMI-Edison for Deep Well Submersible Pumps and Motors, Cables and Splicing Gels in an amount not to exceed Five Million Four Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$5,437,468.74). This amount covers the potential life of the contract including the initial three-year contract term, the two possible one-year renewal options, and the ten percent (10%) contingency for the overall five-year term. This request is reasonable, prudent, and necessary as submersible pumps and

WHEREAS, there were one responsive and responsible bidder who met the submersible pumps and motor, cable and splicing gel requirements of IFB 2024-19; and

WHEREAS, IFB 2024-19 offers were evaluated by GWA's review committee who determined that the offer of submersible pumps and motors, cables and splicing gels made by JMI-Edison was fair and reasonable [EXHIBIT A]; and

WHEREAS, GWA accepted JMI-Edison's bid proposal for indefinite quantity bid of low temperature Franklin Electric submersible motors with an estimated total amount of Five

Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$554,729.13) [EXHIBIT B] for the 3-year base term; and

WHEREAS, GWA accepted JMI-Edison's bid proposal for indefinite quantity bid of high temperature Franklin Electric submersible motors with an estimated total amount of Seven Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Six Hundred Ten Dollars and Forty-Five Cents (\$776,610.45) [EXHIBIT B] for the 3-year base term; and

WHEREAS, GWA accepted JMI-Edison's bid proposal for indefinite quantity bid of Franklin Electric and Grundfos Pumps with an estimated total amount of Eight Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Thirty-Five Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents (\$893,035.38) [EXHIBIT B] for the 3-year base term; and

WHEREAS, GWA accepted JMI-Edison's bid proposal of indefinite quantity bid of 3M splicing gels with an estimated total amount of Sixty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-One Dollars (\$64,491.00) [EXHIBIT B] for the 3-year base term; and

WHEREAS, GWA accepted JMI-Edison's bid proposal of indefinite quantity bid of Paige Electric submersible cables with an estimated total amount of Six Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Twenty-Six Dollars and Eight Cents (\$677,026.08) [EXHIBIT B] for the 3-year base term; and

WHEREAS, GWA Management seeks CCU approval of the estimated contract amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Four Cents (\$2,965,892.04) for the purchase of low and high temperature Franklin Electric submersible motors, Franklin Electric and Grundfos pumps, 3M splicing gels and Paige Electric submersible cables for GWA Deep Wells for the initial three-year contract term, as well as an additional One Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Thirty-Six Cents (\$1,977,261.36) for the possible two (2) one-years options to renew the contract to bring the total contract amount to Four Million Nine Hundred Forty-Three Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars and Forty Cents (\$4,943,153.40); and

WHEREAS, GWA Management further seeks CCU approval of a ten percent (10%) contingency to the possible overall life of the contract (five-year term), of Four Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Thirty-Four Cents (\$494,315.34) to bring the total authorized funding to Five Million Four Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$5,437,468.74); and

WHEREAS, the source of funding for the Submersible Pumps and Motors, Cables and Splicing Gels is revenues or IFCIP funds; and

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Consolidated Commission on Utilities does hereby approve the following:

- 1. The recitals set forth above hereby constitute the findings of the CCU.
- 2. The CCU finds that the terms of the bid proposal submitted by "JMI-Edison" are fair and reasonable.
- 3. There was no indication of bad faith or fraud in any of the procurements contained herein.
- 4. All of the procurement herein are in the best interest of the territory of Guam and Guam Waterworks Authority.
- 5. The CCU hereby authorizes GWA management to proceed in the purchase of high and low temperature Franklin Electric submersible motors, Franklin Electric and Grundfos Pumps, 3M splicing gels and Paige Electric submersible cables for GWA Deep Wells in the total amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Four Cents (\$2,965,892.04) for the initial three-year contract term as specified in the IFB 2024-19 "Indefinite Quantity Bid, and with two (2) one-year options to renew, subject to availability of funds and agreement between the parties.
- 6. The CCU hereby further approves an additional One Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Thirty-Six Cents (\$1,977,261.36) for the possible two (2) one-years options to renew should GWA management seek renewal options.

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- 7. The CCU hereby further approves a ten percent (10%) contingency to the possible overall life of the contract (five-year term), of Four Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Seventy-Three Cents (\$494,315.34) to bring the total authorized funding to Five Million Four Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$5,437,468.74).
- 8. GWA Management is hereby authorized to seek PUC approval with the contract of IFB 2024-19 since the contract may exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) as required by the Contract Review Protocol in Docket 00-04.

On October 25, 2024, JMI-Edison was issued the Notice of Conditional Award for the following line items: 3.1A through 3.1AB, 3.1AD, 3.1AE, and 4.0A through 4.0B.

On the same date, October 25, 2024, Frontier Supply was issued the Notice of Conditional Award for the following line items: 1.1A through 1.1J, 2.1A through 2.1J, 3.1AC, and 5.0 through 10.0.

On November 4, 2024, GWA received a formal protest from JMI-Edison contesting Frontier Supply's award for line items 1.1A through 1.1J, 2.1A through 2.1J, and 5.0 through 10.0. As a result, on the same day, GWA Procurement issued a Stay of Procurement. This stay was issued and acknowledged by both JMI-Edison and Frontier Supply.
