18 **COMES NOW**, the GUAM WATERWORKS AUTHORITY (“GWA”), by and through  
19 its counsel of record, THERESA G. ROJAS, ESQ., and hereby files its Petition seeking the PUC’s  
20 approval to award an Indefinite Quantity Contract to JMI-Edison for the purchase of Submersible  
21 Pumps and Motors and Cables and Splicing Gels for GWA’s Deep Wells, Island Wide.

22 **I. BACKGROUND**

23 On August 15, 2024, GWA issued an Invitation to Bid (“IFB”) 2024-19 for the  
24 procurement of Submersible Pumps and Motors, as well as for Cables and Splicing Gels for  
25 GWA’s Deep Wells. The procurement was issued as an Indefinite Quantity Award requiring an  
26 awarded bidder to maintain sufficient stock and ensure timely replenishment of submersible  
27 pumps, motors, cables, and splicing gels as needed. GWA regularly purchases these essential  
28 items and maintains a minimum critical inventory level to ensure the reliable production of water  
island wide.

**ORIGINAL**

1 In response to IFB 2024-19, two interested vendors submitted bids but only JMI-Edison  
2 was found responsive and responsible for most of the supplies procured. GWA's review  
3 committee evaluated the bid offers, and a copy of the evaluation committee's review is at **Exhibit**  
4 **A**. Tables at **Exhibit A-007-009** also provide a summary of the estimated quantities that GWA is  
5 likely to purchase and the unit costs per year for a three-year base term, option years, and total  
6 contract costs for the supplies listed below:  
7

- 8 (a) Low Temperature Franklin Electric Submersible Motors
- 9 (b) High Temperature Franklin Electric Submersible Motors
- 10 (c) Franklin Electric and Grundfos Pumps
- 11 (d) 3m Splicing Gels; and
- 12 (e) Paige Electric Submersible Cables

13  
14 CCU Resolution 11-FY2025 approved the award of a contract to JMI-Edison for Two  
15 Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Four Cents  
16 (\$2,965,892.04) for the purchase of the aforementioned items for an initial three-year contract  
17 term. Additionally, approval was granted for GWA to exercise two possible one-year options for  
18 an additional amount of One Million Nine Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Two Hundred  
19 Sixty-One Dollars and Thirty-Six Cents (\$1,977,261.36). The combined amounts bring the total  
20 contract value to Four Million Nine Hundred Forty-Three Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Three  
21 Dollars and Forty Cents (\$4,943,153.40). In addition, the CCU further approved a ten percent  
22 (10%) contingency for the potential overall life of the contract (five-year term), totaling Four  
23 Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Thirty-Four Cents  
24 (\$494,315.34). This contingency brings the total authorized funding to Five Million Four Hundred  
25  
26  
27  
28

1 Thirty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents  
2 (\$5,437,468.74).

## 3 II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

4 Pursuant to its Contract Review Protocol, GWA hereby seeks the PUC's approval to  
5 contract with JMI-Edison, to purchase Deep Well Submersible Pumps and Motors and Cables  
6 and Splicing Gels for a not to exceed amount of Five Million Four Hundred Thirty-Seven  
7 Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$5,437,468.74). This  
8 amount covers a needed multi-contract period of up to five (5) years with an initial contract term  
9 for three years and two (2) one-year options to renew. GWA requests approval for the full five-  
10 year term due to the limited market for these supplies and the critical necessity for GWA to  
11 maintain an adequate stock of these items to prevent any interruptions in the water supply.  
12

13  
14 In support of this Petition, the CCU approved GWA Resolution 11-FY2025. GWA  
15 Resolution 11-FY2025. This Resolution is attached with its supporting documents and is attached  
16 as **Exhibit A** and is incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.  
17

## 18 III. CONCLUSION

19 Based on the foregoing, GWA requests the PUC's approval for the award of an  
20 Indefinite Quantity contract with JMI-Edison for Deep Well Submersible Pumps and Motors,  
21 Cables and Splicing Gels in an amount not to exceed Five Million Four Hundred Thirty-Seven  
22 Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Seventy-Four Cents (\$5,437,468.74). This  
23 amount covers the potential life of the contract including the initial three-year contract term, the  
24 two possible one-year renewal options, and the ten percent (10%) contingency for the overall  
25 five-year term. This request is reasonable, prudent, and necessary as submersible pumps and  
26

On the same date, October 25, 2024, Frontier Supply was issued the Notice of Conditional Award for the following line items: 1.1A through 1.1J, 2.1A through 2.1J, 3.1AC, and 5.0 through 10.0.

On November 4, 2024, GWA received a formal protest from JMI-Edison contesting Frontier Supply's award for line items 1.1A through 1.1J, 2.1A through 2.1J, and 5.0 through 10.0.
