1. Please provide a copy of the original Pipeline Agreement and RFO Storage Agreement.
2. What does Tristar Terminals Guam, Inc. (“Tristar”) indicate as necessitating the 5% increase? Is there any breakdown of the additional operating expenses that constitute the 5% increase?
3. Will the two-year option extension be subject to the new rates, or do the parties anticipate another increase in the rates?
4. Please indicate whether GPA has any alternatives, other than lease agreements provided by Tristar.
5. What is the estimated timeline to retire Cabras 1 and 2?
