CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

Pursuant to 12 GCA 12103(a), the Guam Public Utilities Commission [Commission] hereby issues to Pacific Data Systems [PDS], a corporation which is licensed to do business within the Territory of Guam, a certificate of authority to provide the following intrastate telecommunications services, in furtherance of its application, which was filed with the Commission on March 1, 2005:

Wireless connection between two points on Guam for the purpose of transmitting data between these two points. Various speeds and service terms are offered.

Data transport using XDSL technology and metallic circuits provided by GTA to transmit data between two points on Guam. Various speeds and service terms are offered.

Prior to providing or reselling any new or additional regulated telecommunications services, PDS shall obtain certification pursuant to 12 GCA 12103 and such implementing regulations as the Commission may establish.

This certificate of authority is subject to the terms, conditions and requirements of 12 GCA 12103 and to all Commission rules, regulations and orders promulgated thereto.
