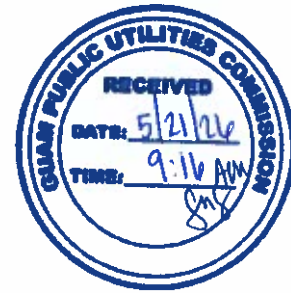

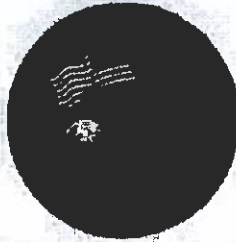

Please be advised that under the Government Claims Act (5 G.C.A., Chapter 6), the government has **SIX (06) MONTHS** in which to investigate and either grant, settle, or deny your claim.

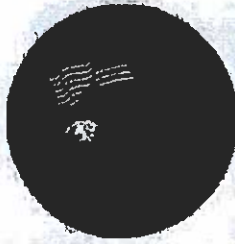

Re: Demand for Payment of Grid Support Costs

Dear Mr. Benavente:

As you know, beginning in March 2025, GPA requested that Doosan Ukudu Power LLC (“DUP”) provide grid support to address generation shortages on the island. DUP provided that support to supply power to GPA’s grid and avoid load shedding through December 2025. GPA accepted and used that power for the benefit of its ratepayers.

Despite our best efforts to reach an agreement on compensation for this support, those efforts have stalled. As a result, I am writing in one last attempt to resolve DUP’s claim for grid support costs.

DUP is prepared to resolve its claim for grid support costs for the amount of \$11,300,000.00 broken down as follows:

Item	Amount
Warranty Extension & Related Costs	\$2,500,000
Manpower for grid support	\$2,000,000
Consumables	\$1,500,000
Power in October, November, December of 2025	\$5,300,000
Total	\$11,300,000

The amounts claimed include costs that DUP incurred for warranty extensions, manpower, consumables, insurance, and a performance bond extension. DUP worked to minimize these costs, as reflected in its ongoing discussions with GPA and GUP. These expenses were necessary to provide the grid support GPA requested.

If payment is not received on or before Wednesday, **May 20, 2026**, DUP will be forced to pursue all available legal remedies. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.

Good afternoon Ms. Jennifer and Mr. Son

As we discussed separately, but the other people's reference, We are sending this e-mail in response to your request.

Upon receipt of your message, we have been actively making every effort to communicate with Siemens PM and on-site TFAs to operate the turbine for a limited period of time.

However, Siemens holds the strong position, and Siemens desires to get a confirmation regarding the Equipment's warranty issue under the contract first before proceeding this task. While Siemens PM has been reviewing this, SE on-site TFAs says that they cannot conduct the further action without Siemens PM's

approval.

Due to time differences between Guam and Orlando (Siemens PM's HQ), we are currently unable to contact to the responsible persons.

Considering the local urgent power demand, we are planning to perform the commissioning activity for Unit 3 which is originally scheduled for tomorrow.

Today, we plan to operate GT at full load for two (2) hours as part of the commissioning process. Please note that the gearbox inspection is required after two (2) hours' full load according to Siemens' procedure, so we cannot operate more beyond this two (2) hours.

We apology for not being able to meet your request today, but please be assured that we will continue the discussion with Siemens.

We will provide an updated news to you tomorrow.

Mr. Son,

As we discussed briefly last Friday GPA would like to seek assistance from Ukudu during generation shortages especially as we move into the hotter months increasing our demand. We understand that GPA provides test fuel and that Ukudu should be credited any fuel used for the purpose of GPA support.

With all existing units available GPA, at current rated unit capacities, should have over 311 MW of total capacity which is sufficient to meet projected peaks, however we do not have the reserves necessary to serve peak when we have more than equivalent of two baseload units or 80MW down. GPA does have sufficient capacity during the day with it's solar contracts. Support would really be after solar production goes away from about 5pm to 9pm.

It is understood that testing is a priority and the units are still undergoing tuning however as you are aware it has been difficult to maintain our Cabras units especially the boilers. Any support you can provide will be most appreciated. Please let me know how we can make this work.

Dear Jennifer and Mario,

I heard that GPA requested to hold the load during the GT#2 testing last night, due to the grid issue that you had. As you know we have a cap of commissioning fuel that GPA provides under ECA and there is a certain cost to run the unit even if we are under commissioning stage such as considerable payment to Siemens which is based on the GT operating hours.

Yesterday event was short and compared to all the support that GPA has provide us so far, this should be minimal, however, if this additional dispatch occurs frequently for prolonged period it could become a burden for the project. While we are always happy to support your grid, we would like to record these additional operating hours requested by GPA during commissioning, and eventually discuss a compensation and/or adjustment of commissioning fuel with GPA if there is any substantial impact near COD.

This would not be an issue if it does not occur often, but my message is just for heads-up and not too be any surprise in the end. Thanks for understanding in advance.

Yesterday GT2 had been tested for 100% Load Operation.

GT2 started @ 16:32, Synchronized to grid @17:02. At 17:39 GT Load up to 75% (39MW) and held for 1 hour, though all parameters were within the normal operating conditions, the Gear Box Casing Vibration DE had been gradually increasing. (See Attached File for reference)

At 18:44 GT2 reached the 100% load and supposedly held for only 1hr but due to some grid issue, GAP requested to hold the GT2 load.. At 20:03, GT2 had started decreasing the load down to 10MW at 20:16. At this load, the GT2 Bearing #2 vibration gradually increased (see attached file). As per GPA request, GT2 increased to 20MW at 20:46.

At 20:50, GT2 had started reducing the load for shutdown, off grid at 20:57.
